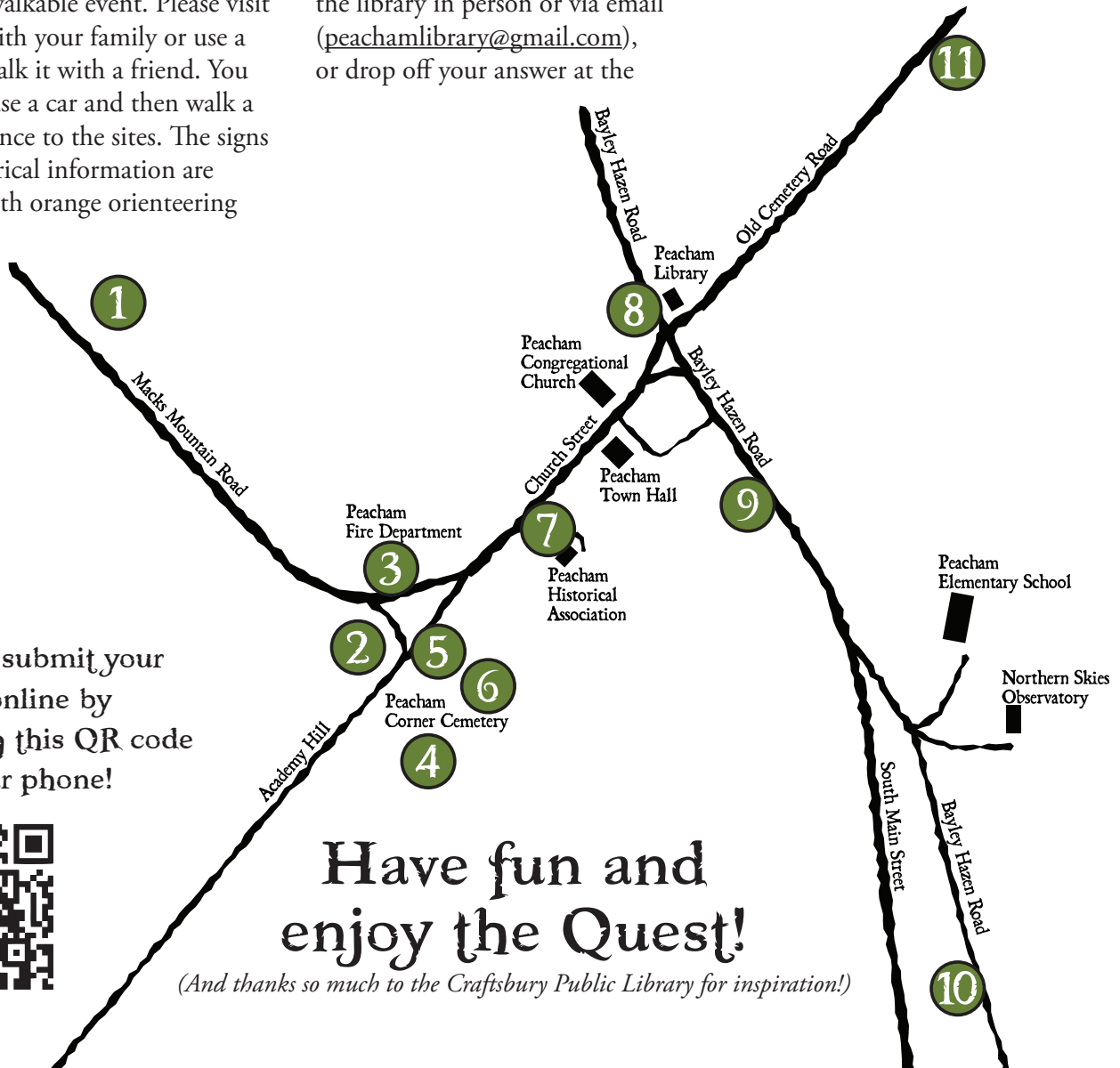
Eleven sites have been identified around Peacham village that mark the town's history fighting off diseases and epidemics. To visit them, you'll need the map below. The Quest is designed to be an outdoor, walkable event. Please visit the sites with your family or use a mask to walk it with a friend. You may also use a car and then walk a short distance to the sites. The signs with historical information are marked with orange orienteering

flags. Please be respectful of the landowners who are granting you permission to walk on their property.

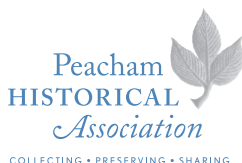
